

Here's how to apply.

First, you need to set up a financial aid appointment with the financial aid coordinator. You will need to bring with you proof of your previous year's income. The financial aid coordinator will review your application, determine eligibility for financial aid and suggest alternatives that may be available.

Please remember that each funding source has specific eligibility requirements and that the processing of your application will take time.

Financial aid recipients must maintain satisfactory academic progress regarding grades and attendance.

- No repayment
- For injured workers

- May assist qualifying people
